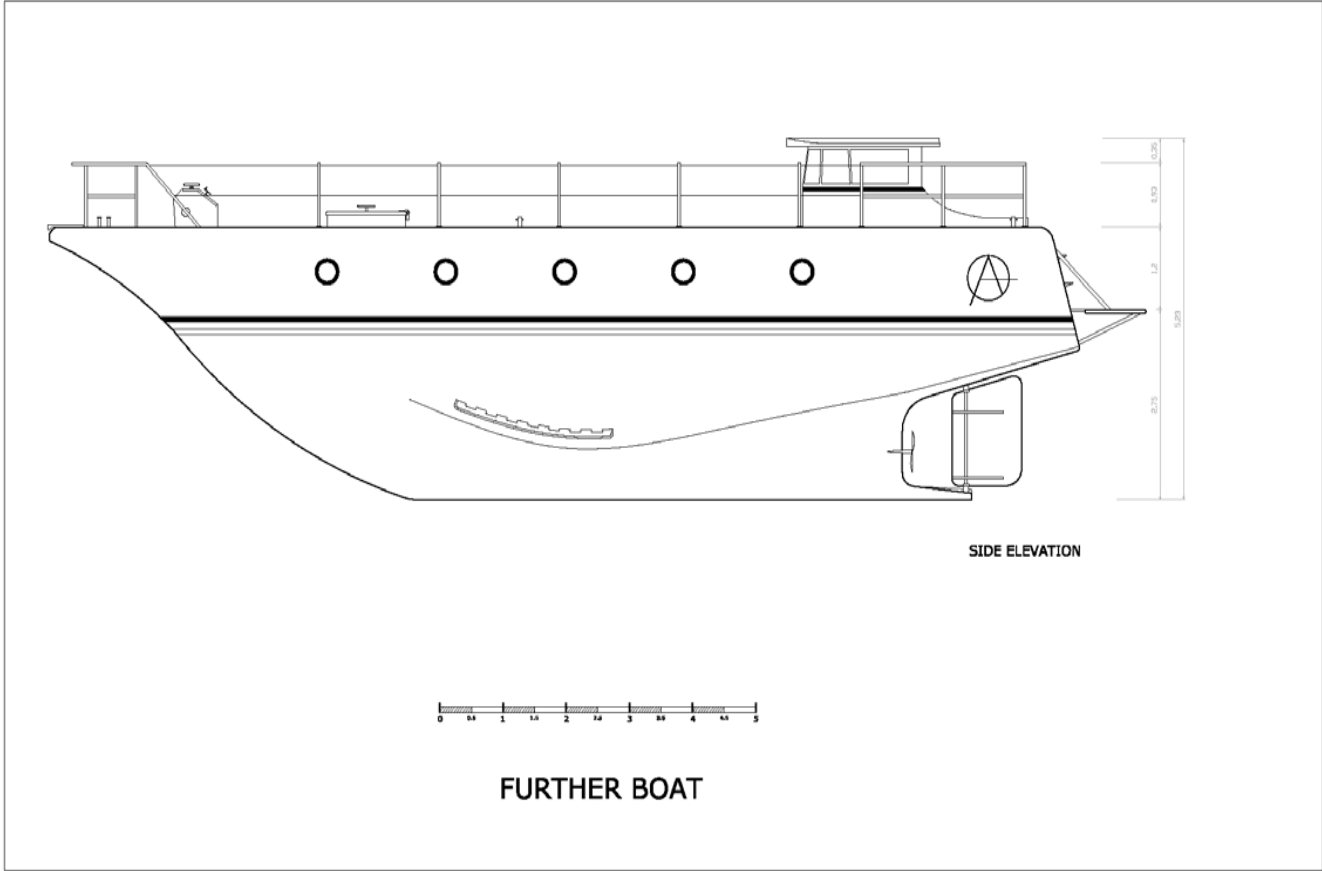






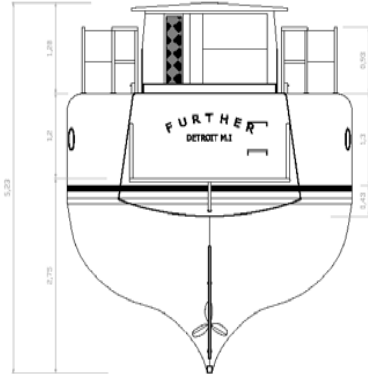




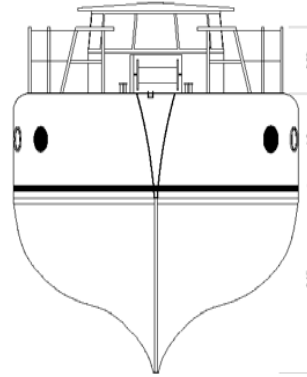








REAR ELEVATION
